

This guide was funded in part through the Federal Aid in Sport Fish Restoration Program, Project F-21-R.

Revenue for this program is derived from a manufacturer's excise tax on fishing tackle, motorboat fuels, certain imported boats, and other fishing gear. This tax is ultimately passed on to you, the customer, through the price of the items that you purchase. Your fishing license fees are matched with funds from the program to:

- Construct and maintain fishing and boating access facilities.
- Support an aquatic resource education program.
- Conduct a program of fisheries management research.
- Maintain and enhance fish habitat.
- Develop state fish hatcheries.
- Maintain and repair small dams.
- Acquire new fishing and motorboating access sites.
- Conduct fisheries management surveys.
- Renovate stunted fish populations.
- Develop a comprehensive planned management system for fisheries.
- Construct new fishing waters.

Look for the Sport Fish Restoration logo on fishing access sites and other facilities. It is assurance that your tax and license dollars are in partnership working for you.

PUBLIC FISHING WATERS

In South Dakota are some of the finest fishing waters in North America. Between the mountain lakes and streams of the Black Hills and the glacial lakes of eastern South Dakota, anglers will find fishing opportunities in stock dams, prairie rivers, and giant reservoirs. This guide was prepared to help anglers find these fishing waters.

Nearly 30 species of fish provide anglers a variety of fishing adventures throughout South Dakota. The most popular fish include walleye, salmon, bluegill, crappie, perch, bass, pike, trout and catfish. South Dakota's fishing season, with some exceptions (See current Fishing Handbook for fishing regulations), is open year-round, providing quality, four-season fishing.

Lake Contour Maps

Game, Fish and Parks publishes Lake Contour Maps of more than 100 lakes that have been mapped over the years. Lakes with maps are indicated in the guide. Fishermen who would like a map of their favorite fishing waters can get one free of charge from most Game, Fish and Parks offices or by writing to Lake Maps, Game, Fish and Parks, 523 East Capitol, Pierre, SD 57501.

MISSOURI RIVER SYSTEM

They used to call her Old Muddy, but the term no longer applies because today's Missouri River is a far cry from the muddy, winding waterway that Lewis and Clark traveled almost 200 years ago. Four massive dams, built from the late 1940s to the early 1960s, tamed the river and created over 900 square miles of open water. These four large reservoirs now provide 40 percent of the fishing that annually occurs in the state and attract at least half a million anglers.

Game, Fish and Parks began its reservoir studies in the mid-1950s on Lakes Francis Case and Lewis and Clark and in the '60 on Lakes Oahe and Sharpe. Game, Fish and Parks early on recognized the aesthetic, social and economic values to the state of the Missouri River fishery and related recreation.

In keeping with the statutory mandate to manage the fisheries, Game, Fish and Parks designated a staff of biologists, gave them a budget, and made the Missouri River fisheries program a high priority. Facilities like boat access areas were constructed, state recreation areas were developed and fish culture facilities were constructed near the reservoirs.

The Reservoir Research and Management staff developed methods to monitor fish populations in the reservoirs. State-of-the-art techniques are used to gather biological data to evaluate current fishing regulations and management. The mission has been designed to maximize recreation fishing opportunity while not jeopardizing the long-term well-being of the fish populations. Department biologists have developed management plans that establish goals and objectives for each species management in the reservoirs. They are continually trying to make the reservoir program more efficient and progressive.

SOUTH DAKOTA FISHERIES MANAGEMENT

South Dakota is blessed with over 700,000 acres of public fishing waters. Most of it is concentrated in the Missouri River Impoundments, right in the middle of the state away from any of the major population centers. Many natural lakes dot the eastern third of the state, however, and numerous impoundments have been constructed over the rest of the state. Eight major tributary rivers and the Missouri River provide abundant fish opportunities, not to mention the smaller streams from the Black Hills in the west to the Prairie Coteau in the east. In all, there are 450 public fishing lakes and 10,000 miles of streams and rivers managed for fish.

Those waters are divided into four management regions and the Missouri River corridor. The Department of Game, Fish and Parks fisheries program goal is to provide the greatest amount of fishing recreational opportunity possible without harming the resource. To accomplish its goal, managers conduct fish population surveys, develop lake and stream management plans, manipulate fish numbers, preserve and improve habitat, develop harvest strategies and recommended regulations, plus involve themselves in many other activities geared to maintain or improve fishing.

The department operates three fish hatcheries, three spawning stations, and a salmon spawning and imprinting station as support facilities for the fish managers. The U.S Fish and Wildlife Service also operates a National Fish Hatchery in the state where fish are reared for use in the Missouri River system. Annual production of hatchery fish for restocking lakes and rivers number in the millions. These stocks are not used indiscriminately but are placed according to the need determined by surveys and as prescribed in management plans. Approximately \$1 million is expended yearly to rear and distribute fish. As one would expect, a system of quality use assurance is used to ensure the best results possible are obtained from the state's expenditure and efforts.

Fishing is one of the leading outdoor activities. It is highly valued by South Dakotans and visitors alike. Every year nearly 300,000 anglers spend more than 3.5 million days fishing in South Dakota waters. Catching fish is just one of the things that makes the sport enjoyable, but it may be the essential ingredient that makes fishing appeal to so many. Fishing is good in South Dakota, and anglers here have a wide variety of waters in which to pursue their sport.
